Sh. 2. The Committee was apprised that Expression of Interest was invited in the month of May, 2015 as per the guidelines for implementation of National Action Plan for Skill Development of PwDs. In response, about 487 proposals were received as on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2015.

**3. Proposals from Government Organizations:-**

16 proposals were received from Government Organizations. The proposals were evaluated based on the documents submitted by them. The proposals were considered by the Selection Committee. The Organizations who are recommended to be empaneled as Training Partner, are shown below in table 1:

**5. Evaluation Pattern for EOI from Non-Government Organizations:-**

The Committee discussed the criteria of evaluation of the proposals. It was decided that the proposals would be evaluated on a scale of 100 marks based on the facts and figures submitted by the applicant organizations. The parameters and the weightage to be given to each one of them are shown in Annexure 1, which has been approved by the Selection Committee.

**6. Proposals from Non-Government Organizations:-**

125 proposals from Non-Government Organizations were evaluated based on the marking pattern approved in Annexure 1. Marks were accorded to various parameters based on the approved evaluation pattern and the proposals were evaluated based on the documents submitted by these organizations. The Organizations who are recommended to be empaneled as Training Partner, are shown below, in table 3.


