2. The committee was apprised that total of 491 proposals were received till 31st October 2015. Out of these, 141 were considered in batch 1 in the first meeting by the Selection Committee held on 18th September, 2015 and 254 were taken-up in batch 2 in the present meeting. The Committee was apprised of the marking scheme for the evaluation of the Expressions of Interest approved in the first meeting of Selection Committee, (Copy placed at Annexure 1).

3. Proposals from Government Organizations:-

In batch 2, two proposals from Government Organizations were considered, both of whom were recommended by the Committee to be empaneled as Training Partner. The names are shown below in table 1:
